Our nursery is adjacent to the church office. There are always two adults in our nursery. You may stay with your child if you like.

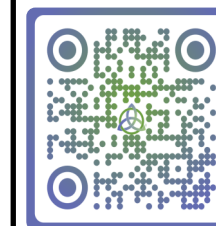

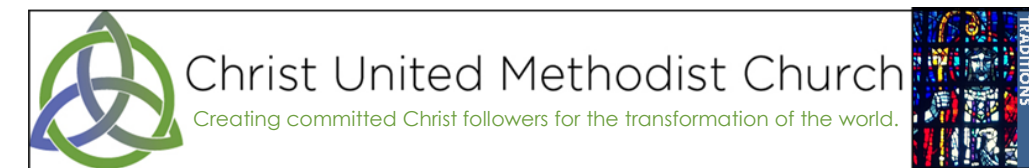

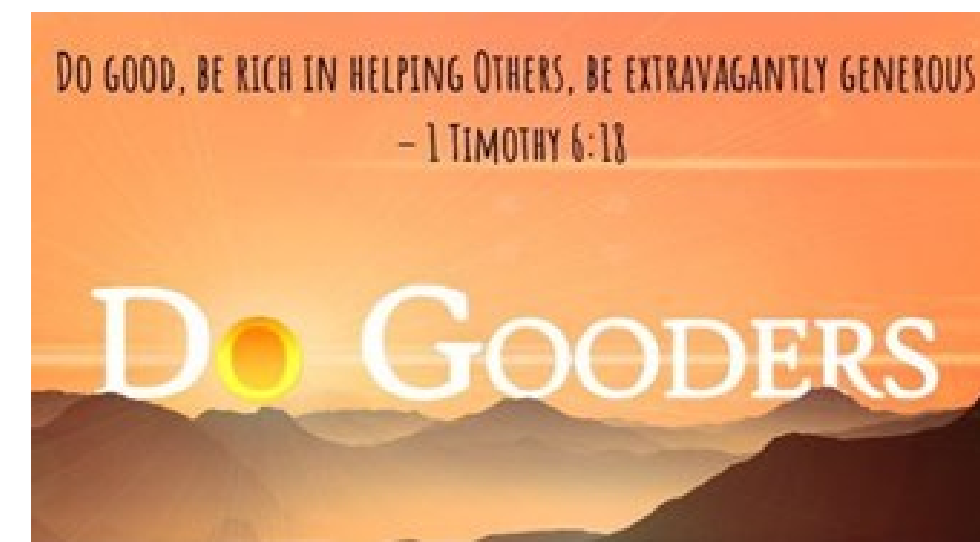
