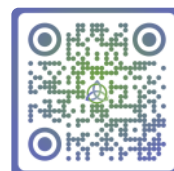

- Come and hear the story of Judith Banya, a little girl in Baiwalla, Sierra Leone, West Africa – one of the poorest villages, in one of the poorest countries, in the poorest continent on planet earth. Of her journey through high school, college, and seminary to become an ordained pastor in the Minnesota Annual Conference and serving churches in Wells, Alden, and St. Paul. Of her return to Sierra Leone in 2013 to start three congregations, build a guest house, host mission groups, oversee the establishment of a high school with 300 students, organize a 30 acre farm, a community center with a store and cantina, and play a leadership role (including being a District Superintendent) in the Sierra Leone Annual Conference. HopePointe Fall Series 2017


