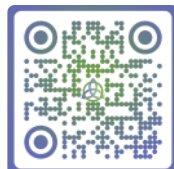

Presenter: Rev. Rick Ormsby, UMC Pastor and former District Superintendent

- Come and hear the story of Judith Banya, a little girl in Baiwalla, Sierra Leone, West Africa – one of the poorest villages, in one of the poorest countries, in the poorest continent on planet earth; her journey through high school, college, and seminary to become an ordained pastor in the Minnesota Annual Conference and serving churches in Wells, Alden, and St. Paul; her return to Sierra Leone in 2013 to start three congregations, build a guest house, host mission groups, oversee the establishment of a high school with 300 students, organize a 30 acre farm, a community center with a store and cantina, and play a leadership role (including being a District Superintendent) in the Sierra Leone Annual Conference. 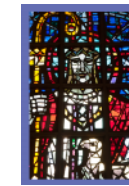
