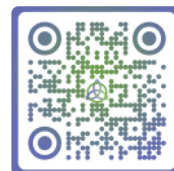

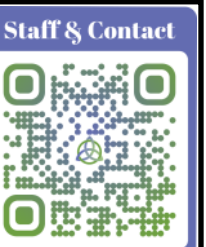
## Ministry Updates:

We're hosting a picnic in the labyrinth on the Second Wednesday of June, July and August. This intergenerational time of fellowship is open to all!

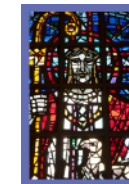
