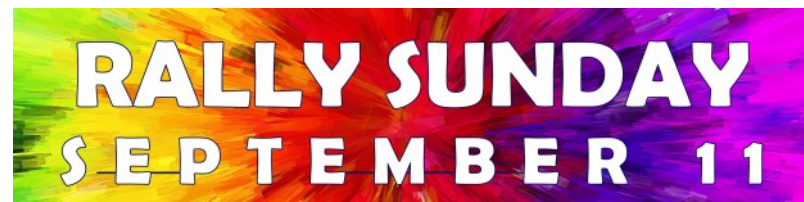

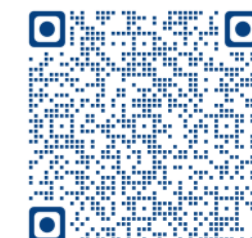
CU Wednesdays is returning September 14!

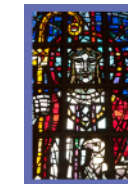
