3:30-5:00 trunk or treat and other activities are open

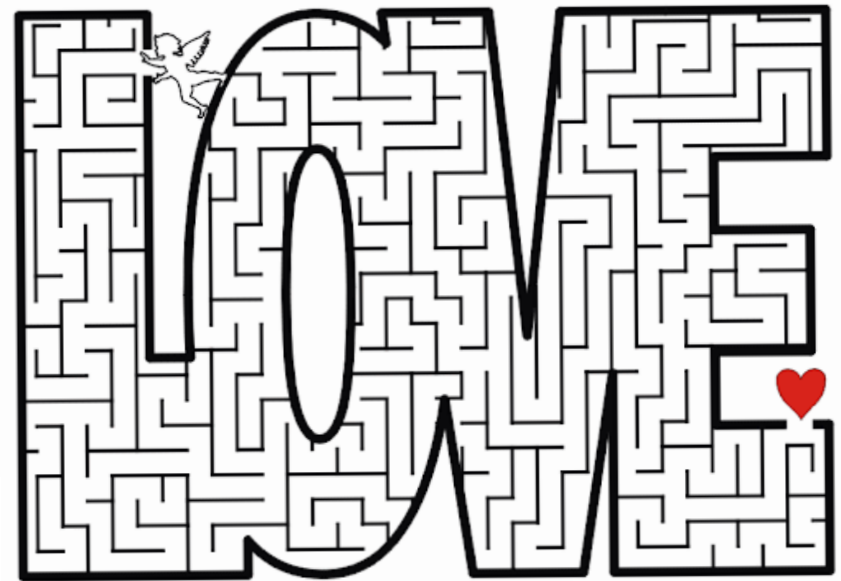
5:00-5:30 clean up and head home
