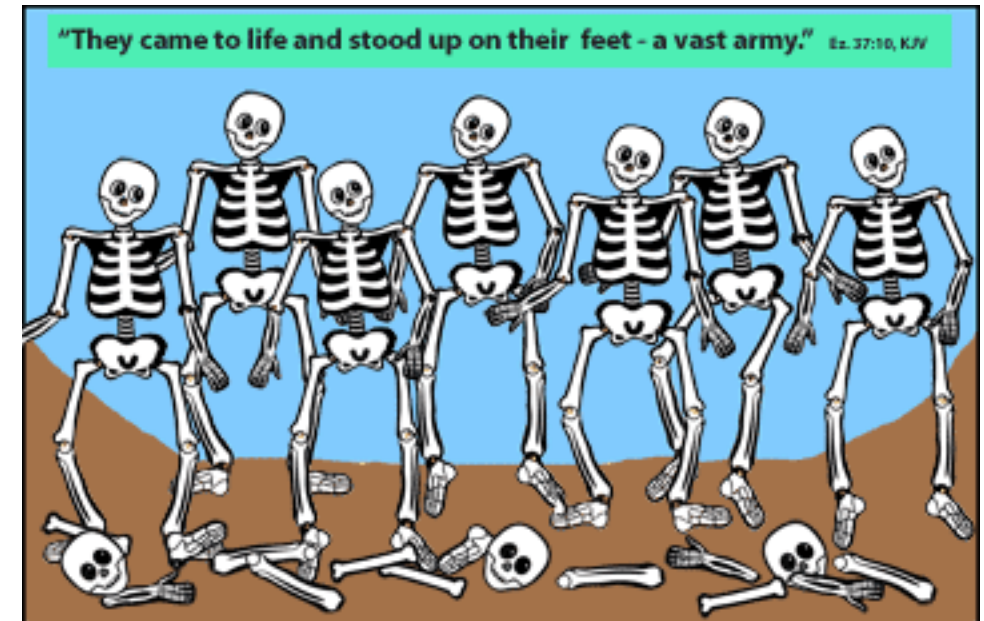

Jesus leads us to abundant life.

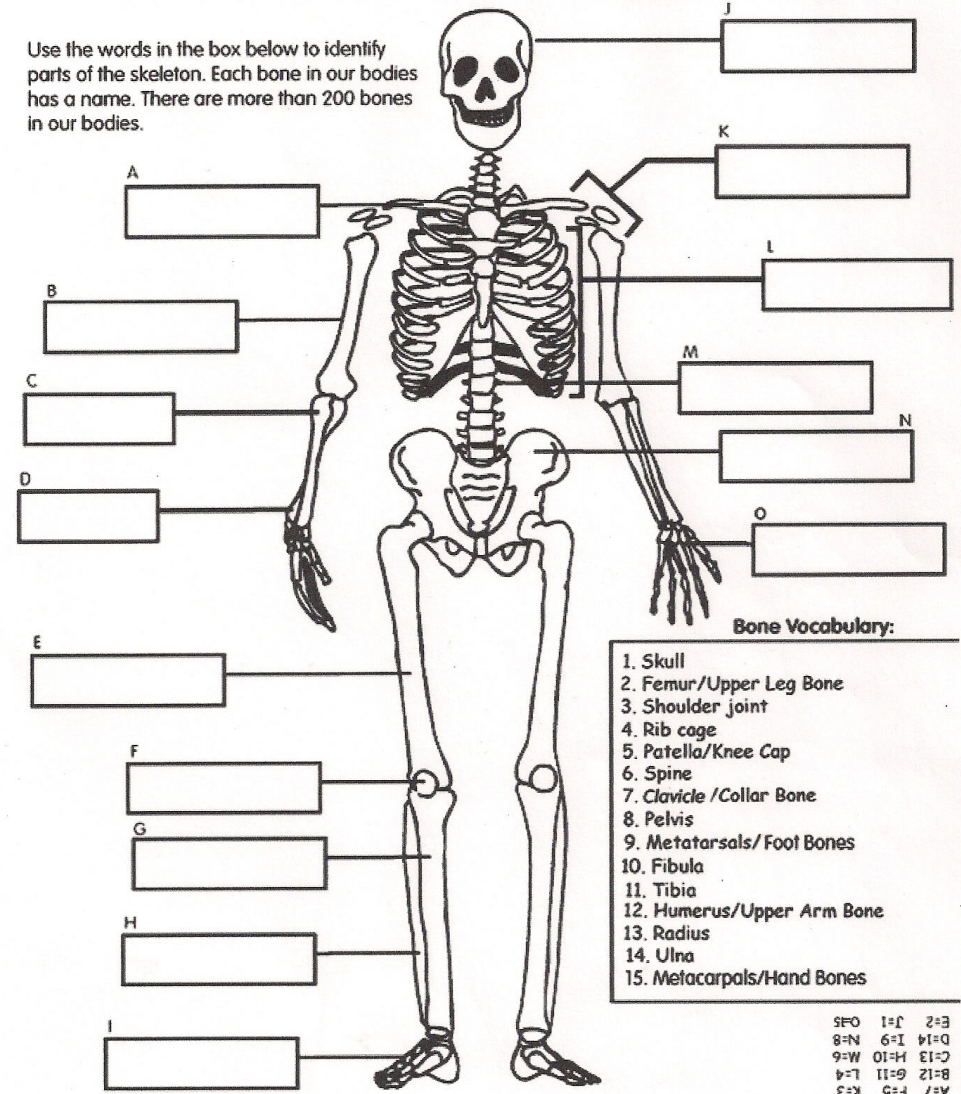
1 Timothy 6:19 tells us giving is one way we experience
