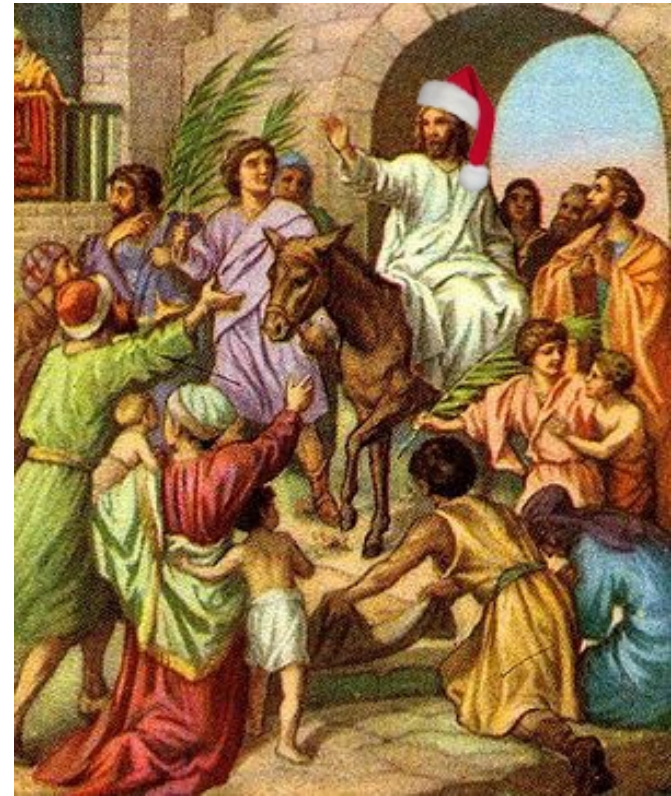
### Soup and Stations (April 10)

the days of Holy Week. Soup and bread served at 5:30.

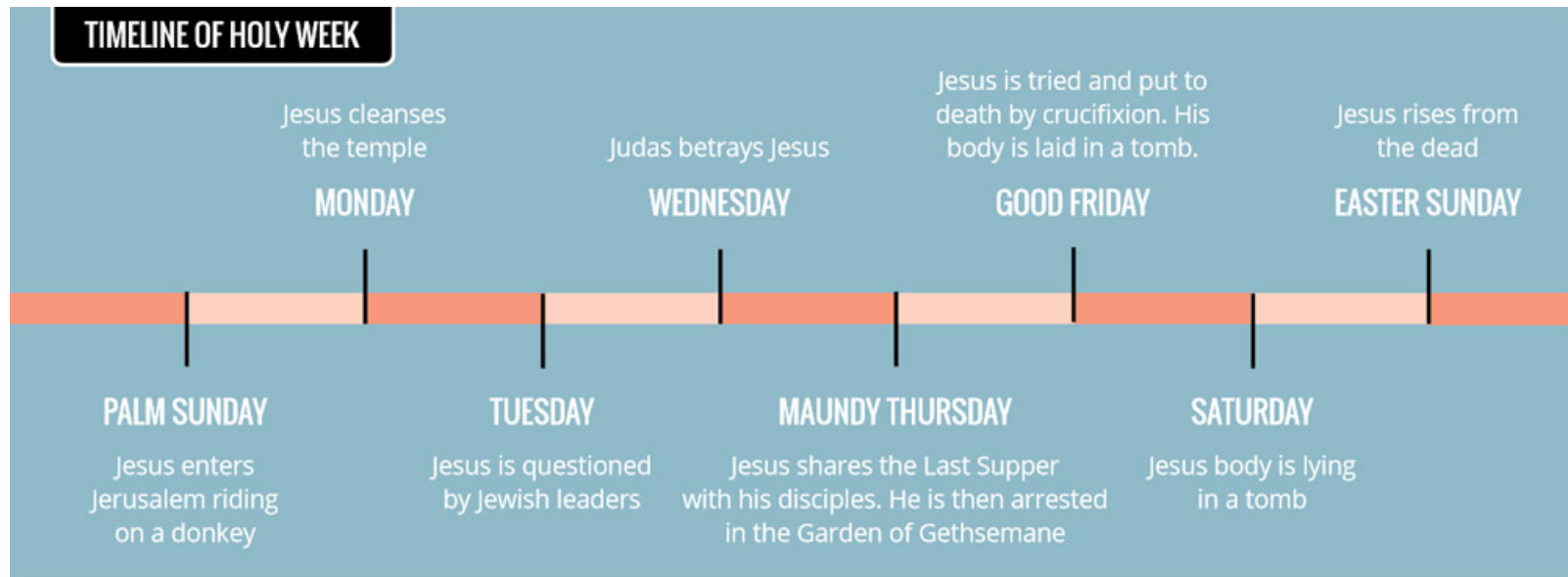
