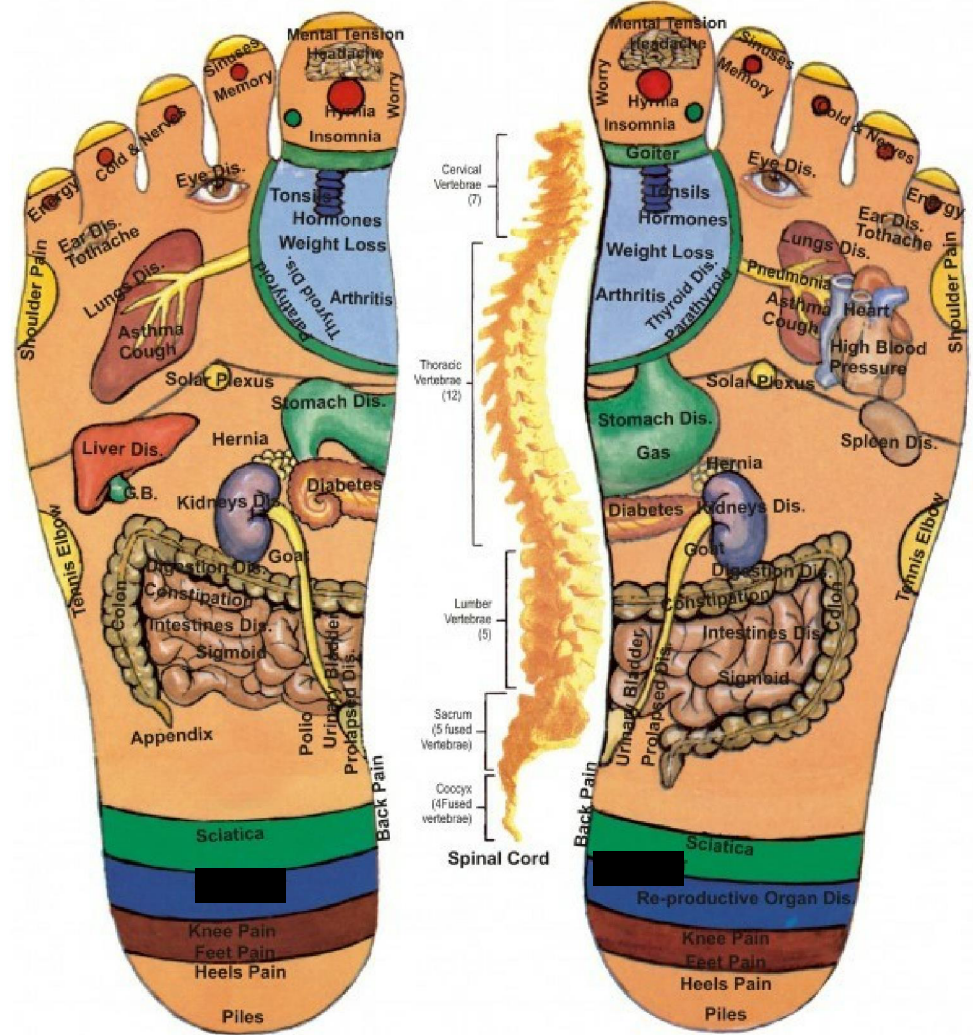
Solve the puzzle to see what Isaiah 52:7 says.
