

This week for Children (up to grade five), Youth (grades 6-12) and Families (our whole church family, with our without children babies to great grandpas!)

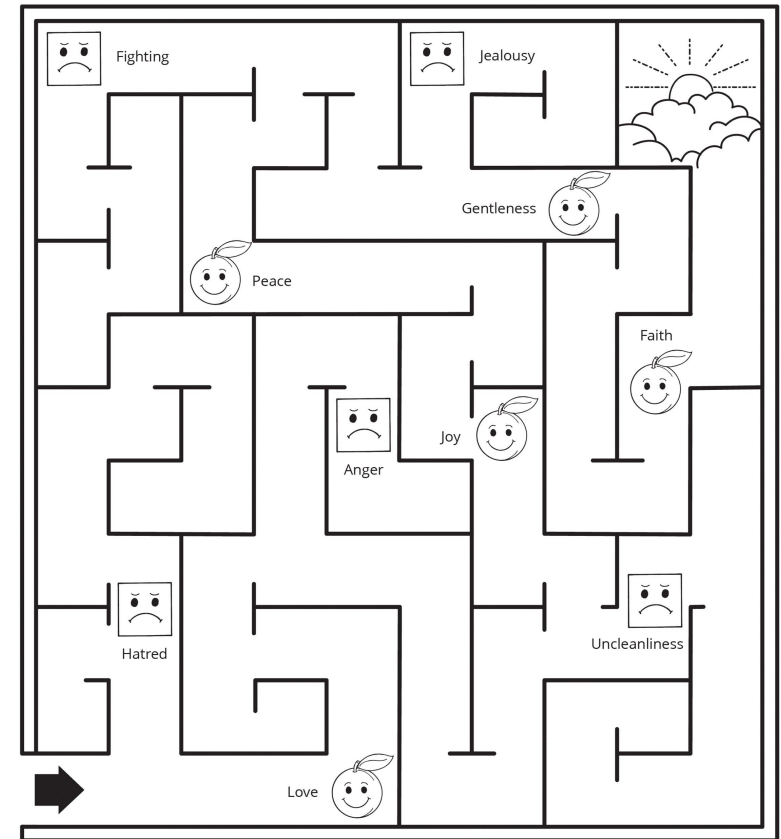
12 (Sunday) "Finding Fellowship" Movie and Zoom 5:00pm (Grades 9-adult)
