WHEN WAS JUNETEENTH AND WHAT DOES IT CELEBRATE?

Juneteenth is America's oldest celebration of the formal ending of slavery. On June 19th, 1865, Major General Gordon Granger led the Union army to Galveston, Texas, where he informed the citizens that the Civil War was over and that all slaves in America were to be emancipated. It is also called "Emancipation Day," and often associated as a "Second Independence Day."

We learned more about how we can be antiracist.

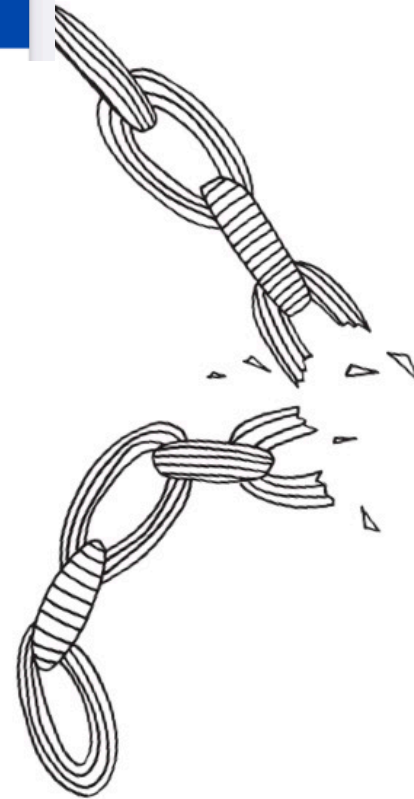
