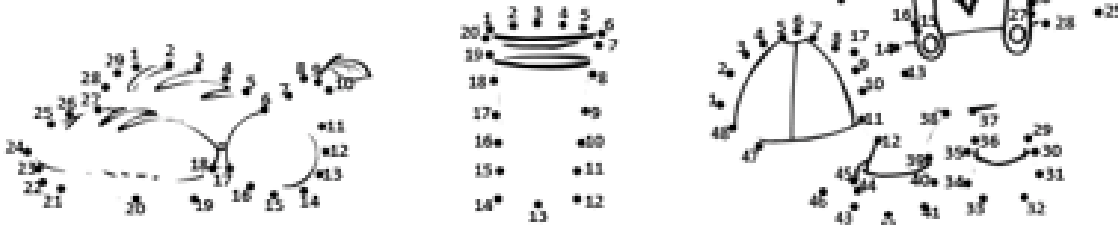

Don't Worry - Dot-to-Dot

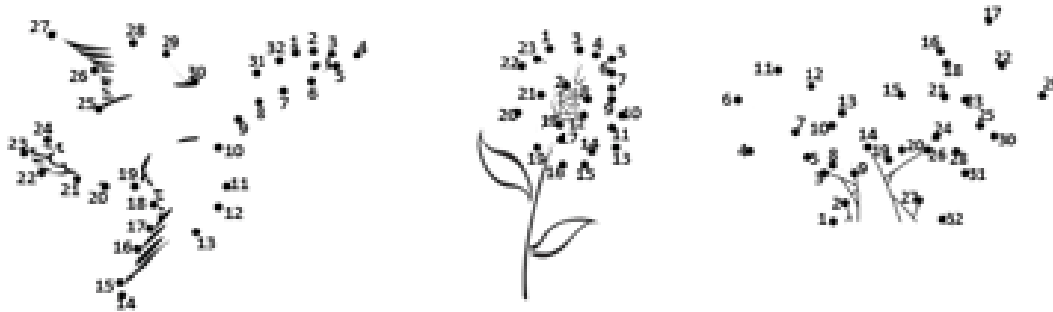

Connect the dots in each picture to reveal what Jesus was teaching.

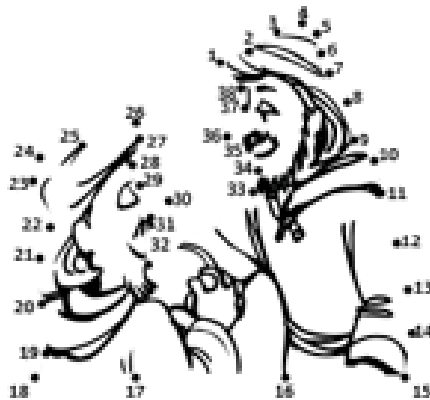
