





WHO IS JESUS?


This Lent we will be exploring the question "who is Jesus?" In the Gospel according to John, Jesus uses the phrase "I am" to describe who he is and what he does.

This is the "Good Shepherd Window" in our church Sanctuary.

- Can you find a king in a crown?
- Can you find a musical instrument?
- Who is this man?
 - He wrote the 23rd Psalm and was a shepherd and musician before he became a king.
- Can you find Jesus?
- How did you know it was him?
- What is he holding?
 - When Jesus says he is the Good Shepherd, it means he will take care of us (like a shepherd does for lambs) and he will keep us from getting lost (by guiding us with his staff.)
