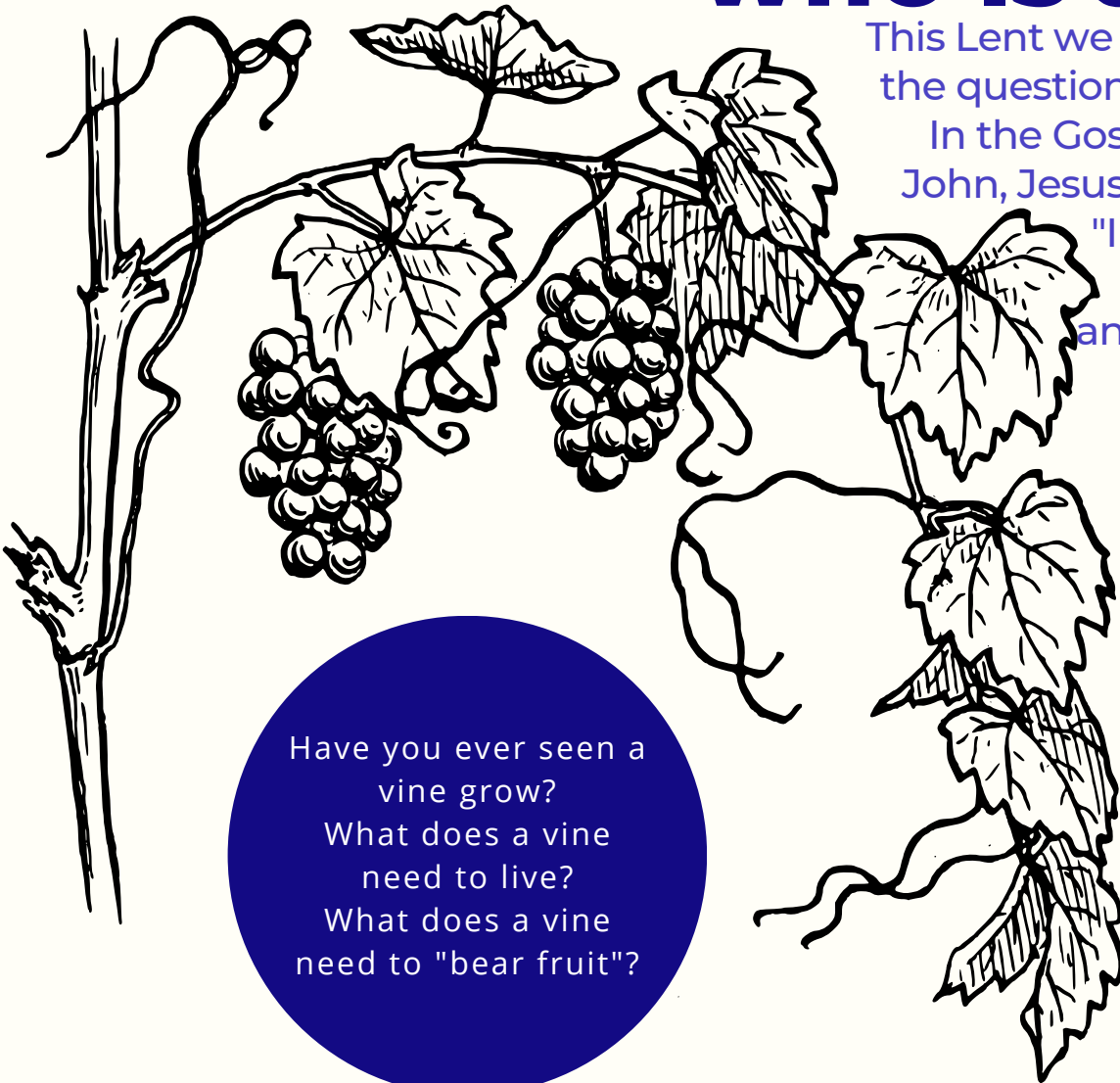

This Lent we will be exploring the question "who is Jesus?"

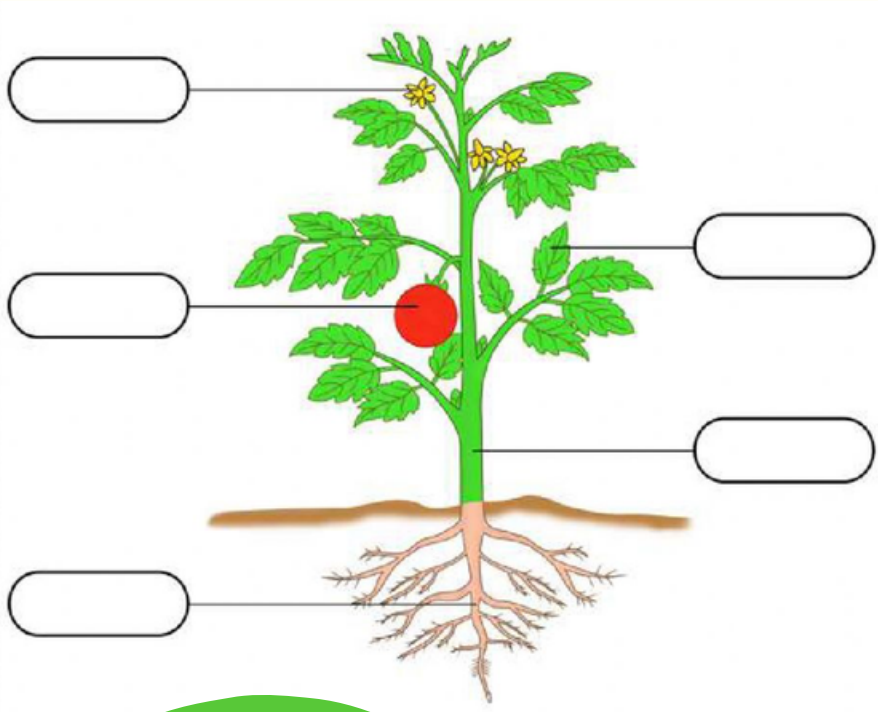
In the Gospel according to John, Jesus uses the phrase "I am" to describe who he is and what he does.
