When you wonder about God, you can look at Jesus and what he said and how he acted. One of our scripture passages in worship today reminds us how Jesus was both God and human.

Though Jesus was in the form of God,
he did not consider being equal with God something to exploit.
But he emptied himself
by taking the form of a slave
and by becoming like human beings.
When he found himself in the form of a human,
he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death,
even death on a cross.


