Jesus told a teaching story.

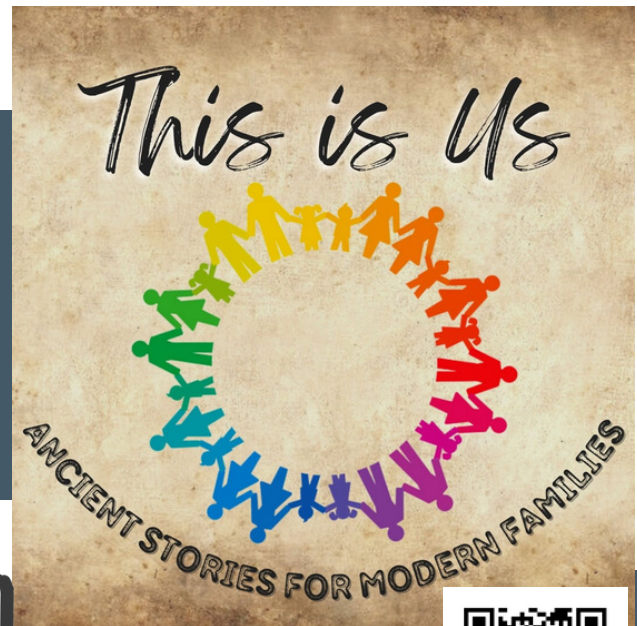
A family had two sons.

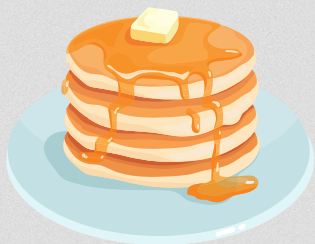
