

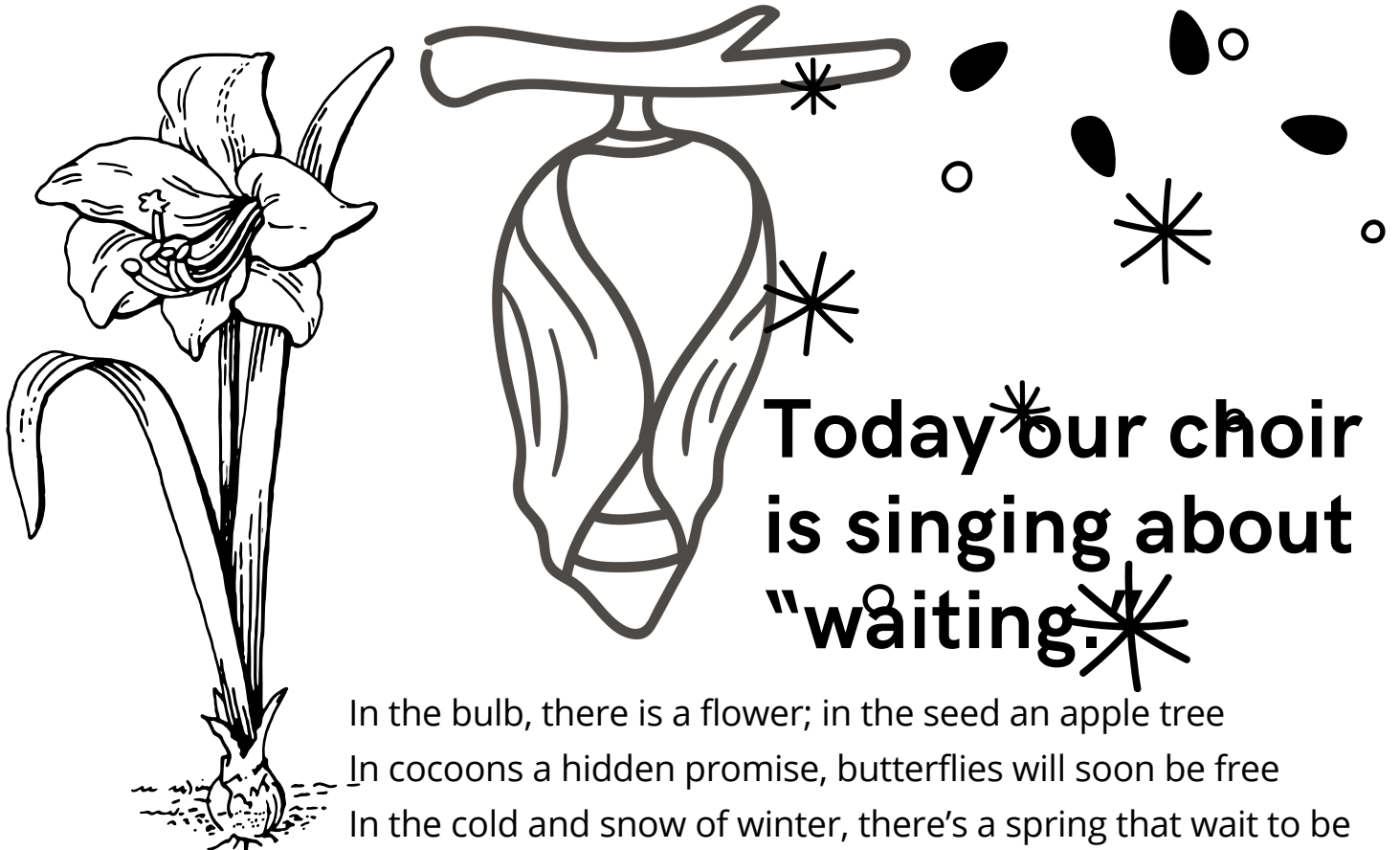


Children, Youth and Family Update

Unrevealed until it's season, something God alone can see

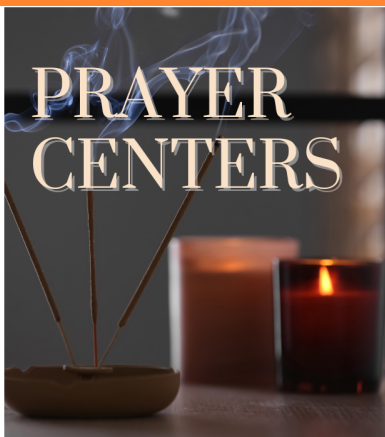
