**Green Tip of the Week from EarthKeepers:** You already are careful not to let the water flow continuously while you brush your teeth. Transfer that same care to getting

dishes ready for the dishwasher. Scrape food off. Compost what you can. Run a mere cup or two of water into a large dish or bowl, shut off the water, start rinsing. You may want to use a long-handled brush. Dishwashers are more water conserving that hand washing, and dishwashers don't require super-clean dishes to start with. Save water.


