Today in between services, we encourage you to sign and address postcards in the Commons that advocate for senators to support two specific pieces of gun safety legislation (HR 8 (The Bipartisan Background Checks Act of 2021) and HR 1446 (The Enhanced Background Checks Act of 2021) which have stalled in Congress. Stop by the table to lift your voice for an end to gun violence.

CU Wednesdays Summer!

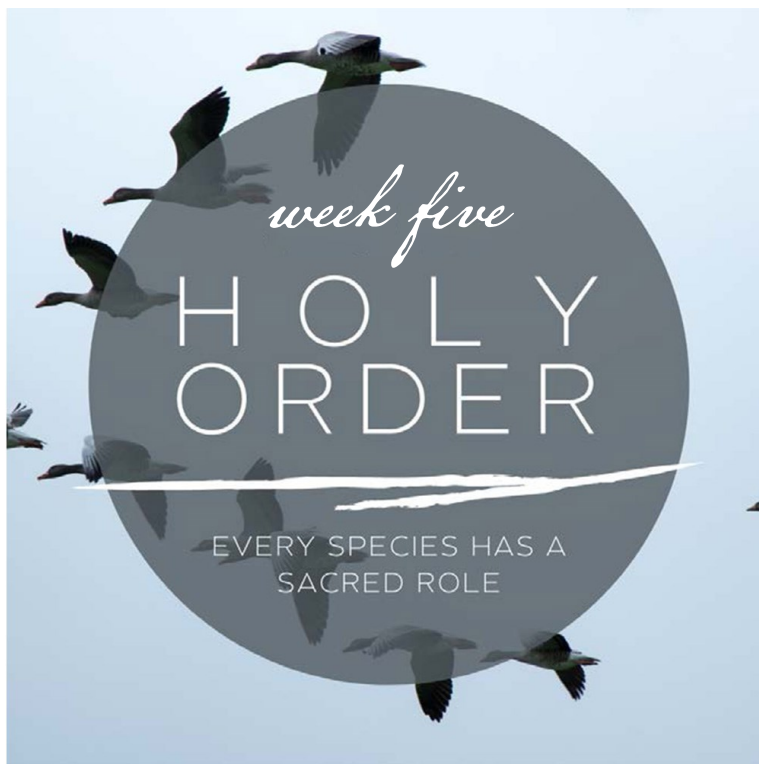
We're hosting a picnic in the labyrinth on the Second Wednesday of June, July and August. This intergenerational time of fellowship is open to all!
