- Finding Fellowship Film Screening June 12 at 5pm (<https://findingfellowship.film>) captures how the seeds for potential reconciliation were planted in the same fields where slave masters once terrorized. This film shares how three churches in Quince Orchard, Maryland came together in the wake of Martin Luther King Jr.'s assassination and offers an example of how communities can unearth their history, realize the power of people coming together, and find fellowship that gives hope. - Our United Methodist tradition is grounded in a call to listen, pray and act with God's love in the world. In 2016, the United Methodist Church passed a resolution specifically calling on United Methodists to advocate for an end to gun violence. Today in between services, we encourage you to sign and address postcards in the Commons that advocate for senators to support two specific pieces of gun safety legislation HR 8 (The Bipartisan Background Checks Act of 2021) and HR 1446 (The Enhanced Background Checks Act of 2021) which have stalled in Congress. Stop by the table to lift your voice for an end to gun violence.
- Third Sunday Forum June 19th - Come and hear the story of Judith Banya, a little girl in Baiwalla, Sierra Leone, West Africa. Of her journey through high school, college, and seminary to become an ordained pastor in the MN Conference and serving churches in Wells, Alden, and St. Paul. And her return to Sierra Leone in 2013 to start three congregations, build a guest house, host mission groups, oversee the establishment of a high school with 300 students, organize a 30 acre farm, and a community center cantina in the Sierra Leone Annual Conference.
