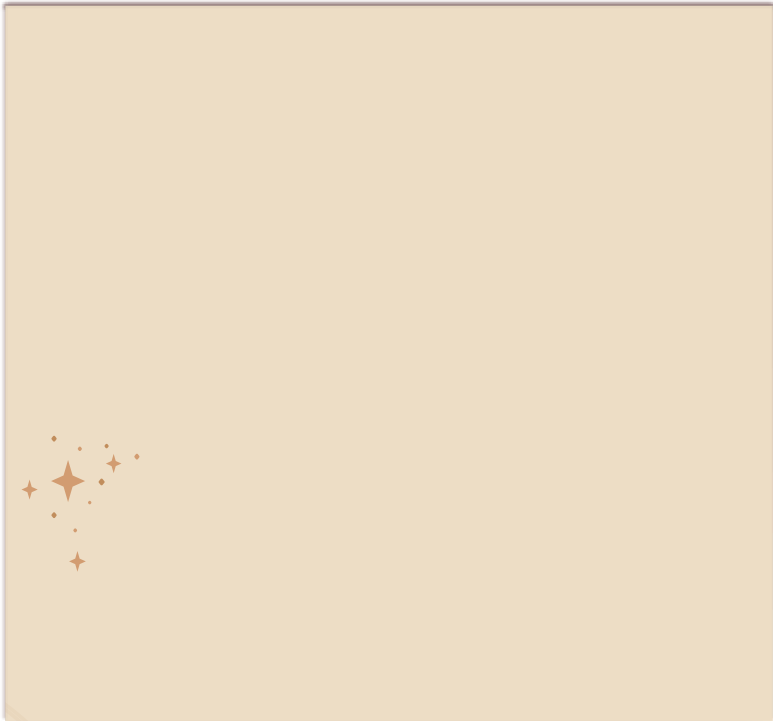
Today in Sunday School children will be learning about communion.

Dinner Conversation Questions

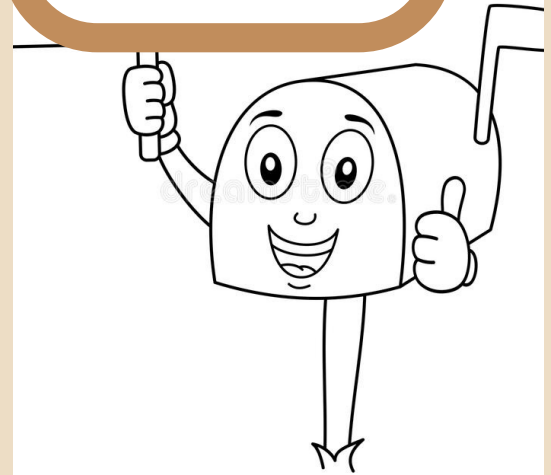
- If you were to get a tattoo of a word or line from the Lord's Prayer, what would it be and why?

Give us this day our daily bread. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven


And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors
